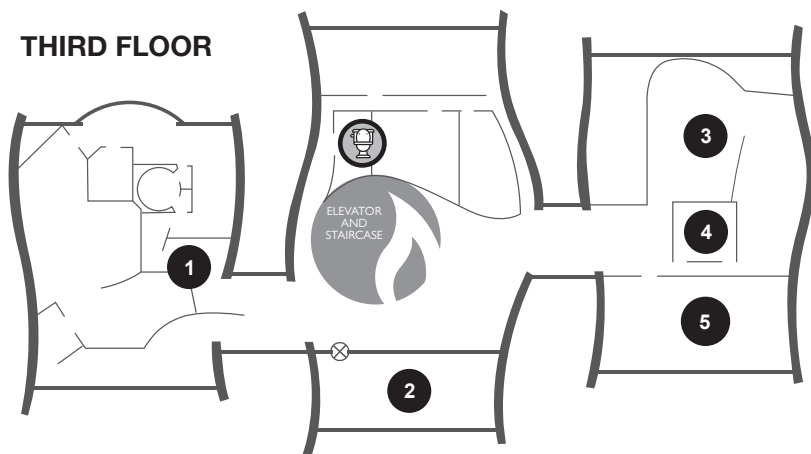
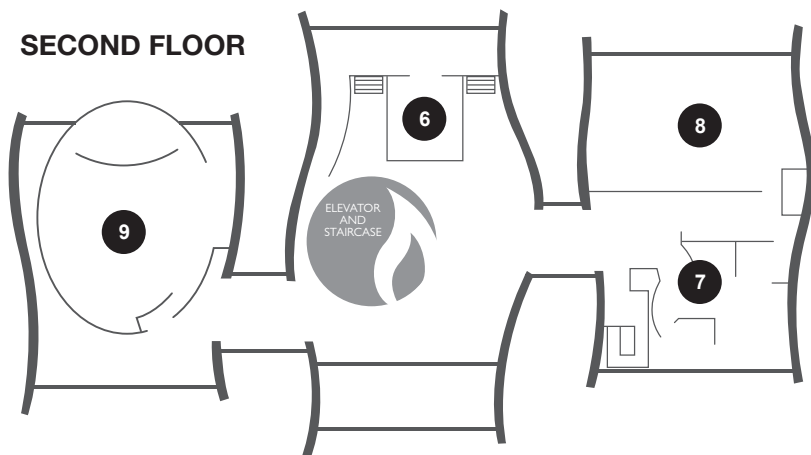


Building Map

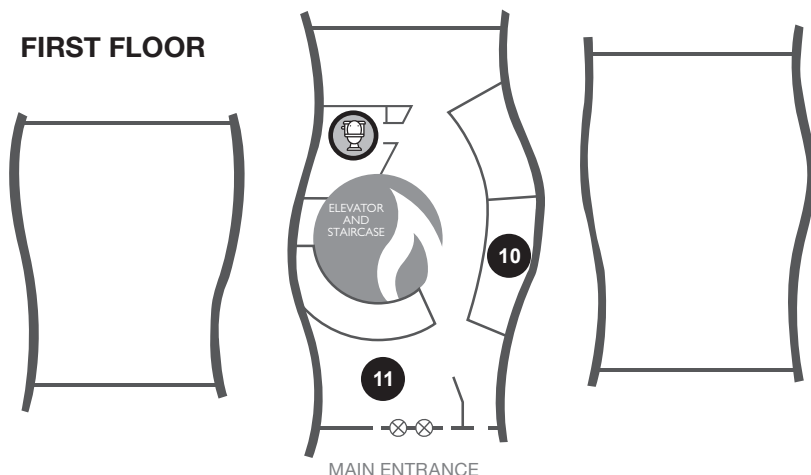

Trace our nation's story from the beginnings of slavery in the Americas through Reconstruction after the Civil War.

- 3 Invisible: Slavery Today**
An interactive examination of slavery in the modern world... and how you can take action.

- 5 Special Exhibition: *Faith & (in)Justice***
